GUARANTEED ENTRY

Deakin sets Guaranteed ENTERs for each of its undergraduate courses. The Guaranteed ENTER for a course is normally less than the Clearly-In ENTER.

The Guaranteed ENTER is the score above which you will be guaranteed entry into a Fee-Paying Place (FPP[®]) at Deakin University in a course at a particular campus. With Deakin's Guaranteed ENTER, you will know if you have a place at Deakin as soon as you receive your ENTER.

Other benefits include:

- » enhances your chances of being selected into the course you want to study at the campus of your choice
- » you can defer payment of your fees through the Higher Education Loan Programme (FEE-HELP)
- » once you have completed 8 credit points of study, and achieved a weighted average mark of 65 in the past 8 credit points, you can transfer from an FPP to a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) for the remainder of your course.

Note: There are no Guaranteed ENTERs for Commonwealth Supported Places.
