

Where does my permit allow me to park?

The chart below shows where your parking permit is valid.

Permit Type	Allows parking in these Parking Permit Zones
Zone 1 Purple	1 5
Zone 2 Yellow	2 4 5
Zone 3 Green	2 3 4 5
Zone 4 Blue	4 5
Zone 5 Red	5
Zone 6 Orange	4 5 6
Zone 7 White	7

How long does my permit last?

The table below shows when your permit is valid.

Permit type	Validity period
Hourly	Until time indicated on permit
Daily	Day indicated on permit
Monthly	Calendar month indicated on permit
Semester 1	01 January 2008 to 21 July 2008
Semester 2	01 July 2008 to 31 December 2008
Annual	01 January 2008 to 31 December 2008

Lost and stolen permits

Replacement permits cost 50% of the original permit cost.

Speed limits

The speed limits at all Campuses are: 40 km/h on roads, 20 km/h in car parks, and 10 km/h in multi-level car parks.

Parking zones

Deakin University has seven parking permit zones identified by signs and coloured line markings on the road surface.

Zone	Colour
1	Purple (Resident Parking)
2	Yellow (University Vehicle Parking)
3	Green (Central Pool Vehicle Parking)
4	Blue (Inner General Parking)
5	Red (Outer General Parking)
6	Orange (Reserved Parking)
7	White (Pay-Per-Hour Parking)

Parking permits

Your vehicle must display a valid permit to park at Deakin University. Daily parking permits are available from permit vending machines in car parks. Monthly, Semester and Annual parking permits are available from the Cashiers' Office.

Disabled parking spaces in permit zones

You must have a valid Category 1 Disabled Persons Parking Permit (from a local council) and a valid Deakin University Parking Permit to park in a disabled bay in a permit zone.

Restricted parking areas

Substantial penalties apply for using No Stopping areas or No Parking areas, or misusing Loading Zones or Disabled Bays.

Parking infringements
